- Prior experience leading/managing others a plus.
- Excellent communication skills with the ability to interact, present to, and influence a group of co-workers, supervisors, managers, or higher-level executives.
- Ability to work well both independently with minimal supervision and within a team environment.
- Ability to read, interpret, and apply documents such as regulatory standards and guidelines, safety rules, owner's operating manuals, service procedure manuals, etc.
